

Zotero Installation Guidelines



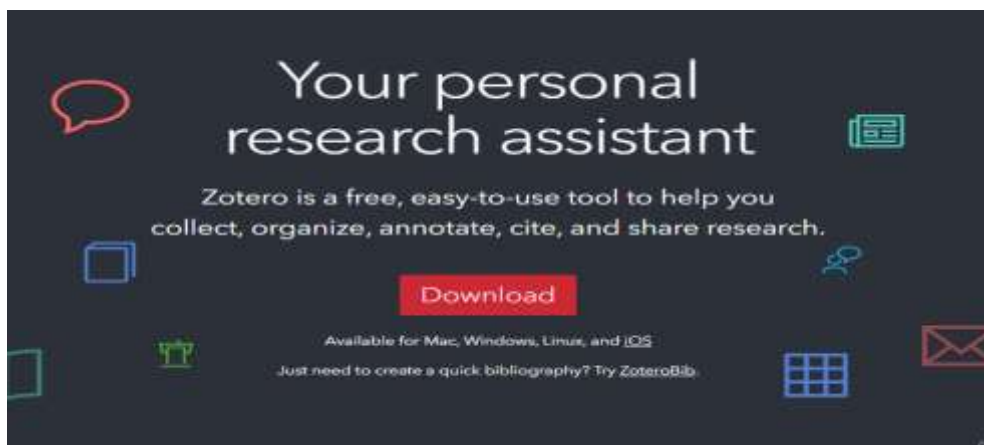
What is Zotero?

- **Zotero** is a free and open-source reference management software to manage bibliographic data and related research materials, such as PDF files.
- Features include web browser integration, online syncing, generation of in-text citations, footnotes, and bibliographies, an integrated PDF reader and note editor, as well as integration with the word processors Microsoft Word, LibreOffice Writer, and Google Docs.

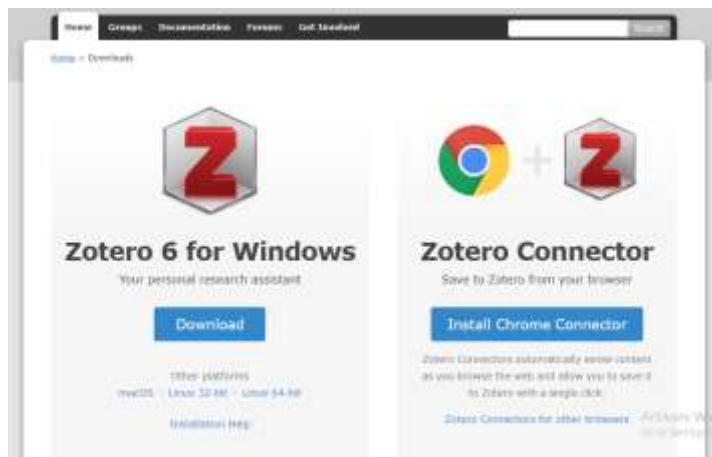
To Download Zotero for your Computer

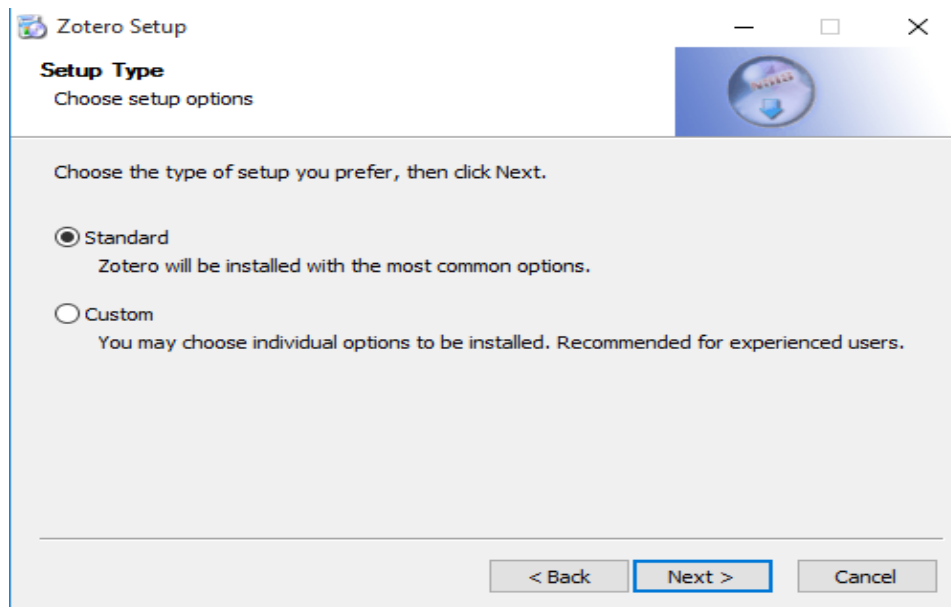
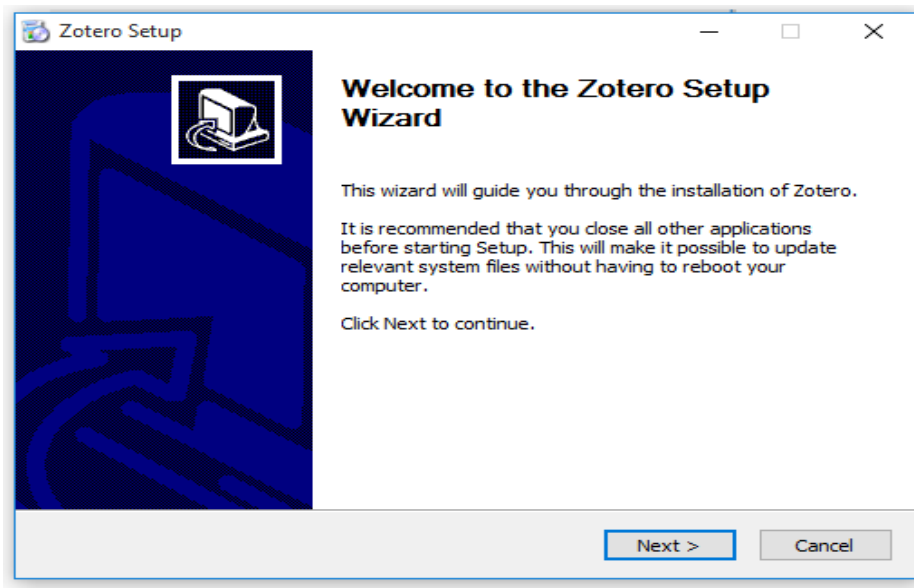


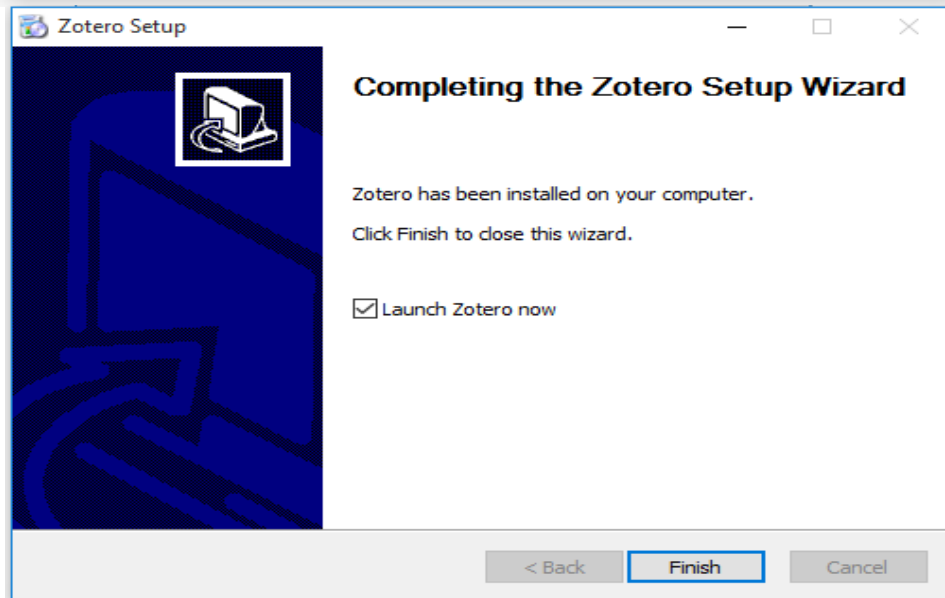
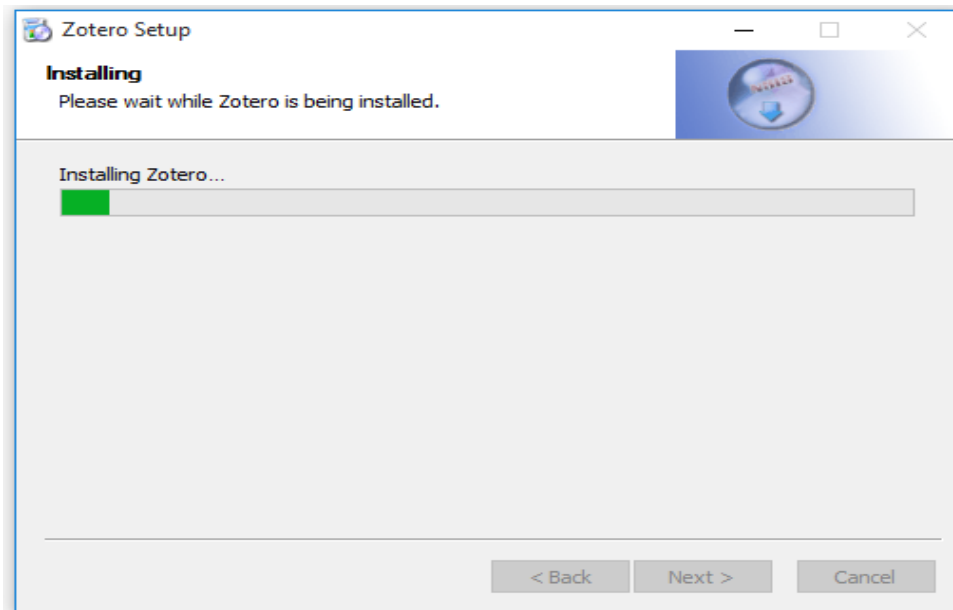
- Click the **Download** Button



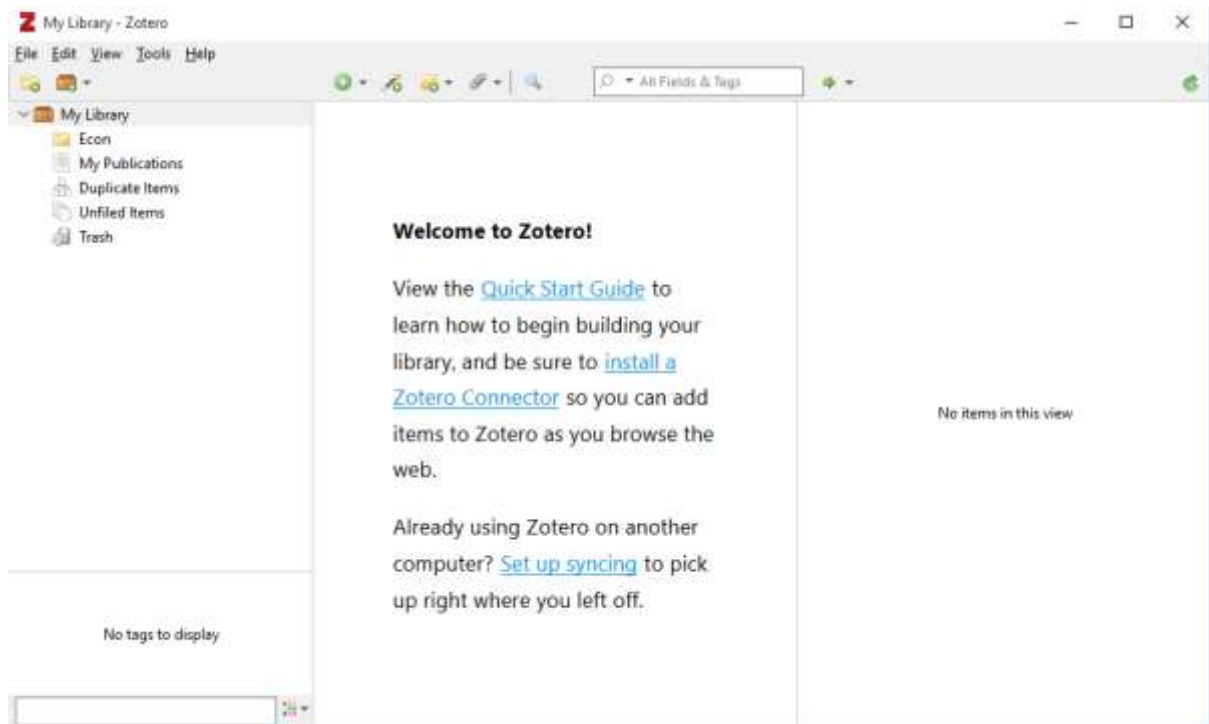
- Click the **Download** button of **Zotero 6 for Windows** side.
- Then go to the downloads and double click on the application software downloaded.
- Follow the instructions as mentioned in the following figures.







Finally you can see the welcome note of Zotero.

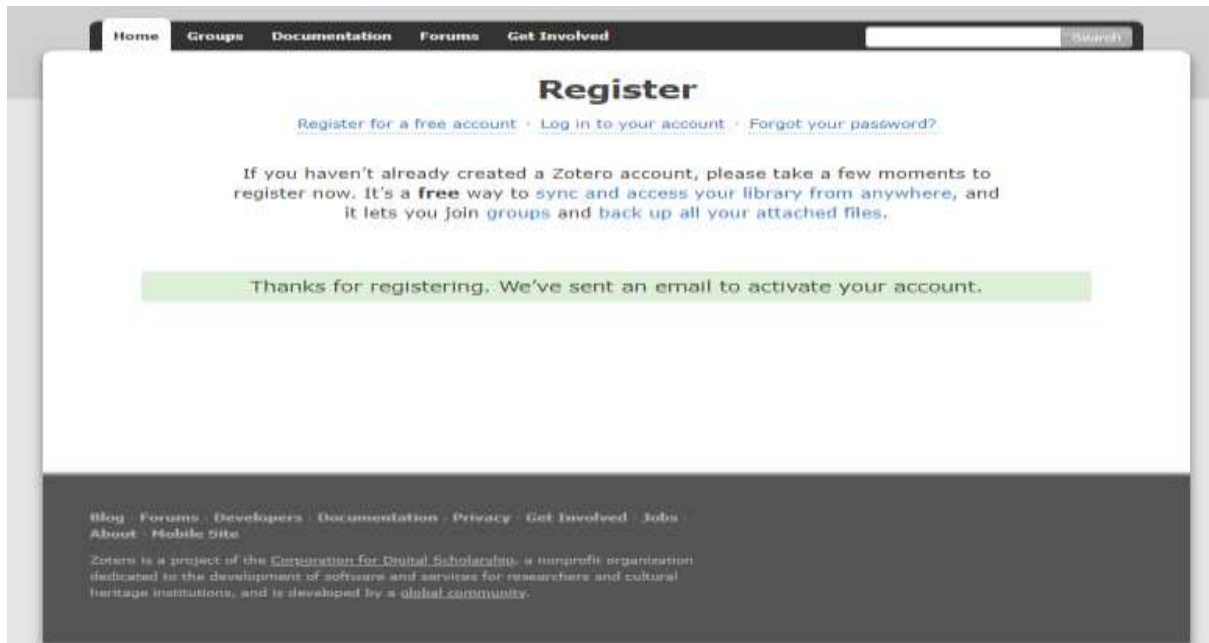


If you need to create an account in Zotero you can go to the Zotero website, and clicking **Register** in the upper right-hand corner of the page.
